Agile Therapeutics Commercial Head Named Bronze Stevie Winner in the 2012 Stevie[®] Awards for Women in Business

Dr. MacFarlane is the commercial head of Agile Therapeutics, and brings over 23 years of experience in the pharmaceutical industry, including drug development, marketing, and sales management. She is leading the preapproval commercial activities for AG200-15, the company's once-weekly, low-dose contraceptive patch, which was recently submitted to the FDA for approval.
